SYNOPSIS



In his mind, the perfect photograph can only be captured in their first seconds of death, moments before they become spirits. The storyline will follow Lucy and her experience with this photographer, in his twisted fictional world. In the end, while showing the portraits, his technique is revealed and the dreamy sequence explained through a conversation Lucy and Oliver had when they first met.

DIRECTOR STATEMENT

Two years ago I was lying in the sun on the beach enjoying a summer crime novel. That night I fell ill, came down with a fever. I had a dream that would eventually turn into the script for Enchanted. A girl was lured into a derelict building that had a swimming pool inside of it. The girl kept hearing 3 feminine voices calling her up. I was just an observer and all I could do was watch how the girl drowned in the pool but came out to the other side joining the 3 calling spirits. Even if crude, the images were beautiful; evoking a very strange contrast. The very next day I started to explore this theme and take it further into the realm of fiction.


The dream made me realise how much in our days the concept of beauty has become crucial. A beauty without imperfection, that is not real. So I began investigating how social media became a portfolio for young ones full of hopes of easily reaching fame and fortune. This is how the story of Lucy started to take form. Our leading lady is chasing such a dream. She is shy yet narcissistic. She knows what she wants and she knows she owns the needed beauty to pursue her goals. Is beauty dangerous? Yes. Also, it never lasts; but Oliver, our leading man, thinks otherwise. For Oliver eternal beauty does exist. But how far can you go in the name of art? And is there a limit to what can be considered art?

I decided to don't include any dialogue and to only focus on images and sounds to induce a more sensorial and dreamy experience. I do love fashion and I do love horror - so I researched for the perfect jewellery brand that could suit the aesthetics of my vision. I presented the idea to Zeemou Zeng and I was positively surprised by his enthusiastic response and willingness to jump into this experimental journey with me. From then on, it was about how to execute this vision and give it justice considering our limited resources. I was very fortunate in this domain as I've had the best producer and key collaborators who believed in me and brought their energy and passion and ultimately helped me make Enchanted possible.



Lee Bridgman as **Oliver**

Trained in all disciplines of the performing arts, Lee is a graduate of the Italia Conti Academy in London. A versatile Actor, he has appeared in theatre, TV and Film, most notably featuring in the Elton John biopic, 'Rocketman' (directed by Dexter Fletcher) in the role of Steve. Further credits include Mark in the award winning short 'MJ' (RSA films) and the West End show 'Wicked'. 
Rosie Johnson as Lucy/Siren




Zeemou Zeng - Jewellery Designer
